Dental Extractions

We understand that a number of GDP's for various reasons are unhappy about being asked to remove teeth as part of orthodontic treatment plans. Although we try to formulate non-extraction treatment plans wherever possible, there will always be cases that require extractions for appropriate and successful management. Extractions are often required not just to manage crowding but also to correct displaced centre lines, reduce overjet's, correct molar relationships and to avoid gingival recession. If you are unsure why extractions have been advocated for your patient, please feel free to ask. We will be more than happy to explain the reasoning.

This gentleman is wearing a lingual fixed brace bonded to the lingual surfaces of the upper lower teeth. These images show his progress in just 4 months. We'll keep you updated with his excellent progress.


One of the most helpful options will be the ability for you to refer your patents online. We will confirm receipt of your online referrals via email. You can also send any general enquiries via our website contact form.
