This patient started treatment with a standard fixed appliance. They found tolerating a fixed brace difficult so the decision was made to remove the appliance (pic 2). Treatment was completed using Invisalign. 27 aligners over 14months have produced this fantastic result!

NHS Waiting List & Validation Days

• • •

Firstly, thank you very much for all your support and referrals over the last 12 months. The demand for both NHS & Private orthodontic treatments certainly remains high! Upon receiving your referral, Mr. Davies will triage each case. If the referral proforma indicates a specific need for early assessment, patients will be offered a validation appointment. Hence the need for thorough completion of the proformas with as much information as possible. Otherwise referrals will be placed on our waiting list in date order. The treatment waiting list is currently 18-24 months. For those not eligible (low IOTN score or over 18) private options are available. If patients are referred at 16, they may not be seen in time for NHS

Private referrals will be seen for a consultation within 4 weeks and treatment started shortly after.
